The Division of Neonatology at MetroHealth Medical Center is now accepting applications for the 2014 Chester Summer Scholars Program. Now entering its 32nd successful year, the Chester Scholars Program boasts more than 380 alumni from over 50 colleges and universities nationwide.

This unique and exciting summer experience accepts up to fifteen (15) medical science students interested in exploring academic medicine and research at The MetroHealth Medical Center in Cleveland, Ohio. MetroHealth Medical Center is affiliated with Case Western Reserve University School of Medicine and is recognized as one of the finest public teaching hospitals in the country.

Each student will work under the supervision of a faculty member on an assigned research project of their choosing. A \$2,500 stipend is awarded to each scholar.

The Chester Summer Scholars Program

A remarkable teacher, scholar, and physician. The late Dr. Edward Chester was known nationally as an innovator in the field of medical education. He was appointed director of the Ambulatory Medicine Teaching Clinic at MetroHealth Medical Center, then known as City Hospital, in 1960 by Dr. Charles H. Rammelkamp, Jr., Director of the Department of Medicine. It was Dr. Rammelkamp who conceived the idea of the ambulatory teaching clinic and asked Dr. Chester to develop and coordinate the program. Dr. Chester served as the clinic's director until his retirement in 1980.

Dr. Chester's association with MetroHealth began in 1936 as an intern at City Hospital. Since 1943, he held an appointment at the Case Western Reserve University School of Medicine and was appointed Emeritus Professor of Medicine upon his retirement. His compassion for patients and students is well known by all who have been taught by, worked with, or knew Dr. Chester, which includes the majority of physicians now practicing in Cleveland, as well as colleagues from around the country. Dr. Chester's humble attitude about his accomplishments belies the great impact his vision and dedication to medical education has had on the ambulatory teaching environment, which is of such great importance in the modern practice of medicine. He has rightfully earned the respect of the entire medical community.

The Chester Summer Scholars Program Application Information

REQUIREMENTS:

- The student must have completed second year of undergraduate studies in premedical or scientific studies by the start of the Program.
- The student must be a resident of Ohio or attend an Ohio college or university.

STIPEND:

Each recipient will receive a stipend award of \$2,500. Supplies and equipment are provided by MetroHealth Medical Center. Parking is provided for the 10 weeks. If housing is required for the summer, students can contact Case Western Reserve University at 216-368-3890 or at <http://studentaffairs.case.edu/living/housing/guest>. Housing will be at each student's own expense and generally runs around \$20 per night.

APPLICATION PACKAGE:

A completed application that consists of the following should be postmarked no later than Friday, February 14, 2014. The program runs from Tuesday, May 27, 2014 through Friday, August 1, 2014.

1. A Chester Summer Scholars Program application must be submitted.
2. A copy of **official** school transcripts (mailed).
3. Three (3) letters of recommendation from individuals with academic or previous scientific work connections (may be sent with application or separately-mailed).

Any application received incomplete or after the February 14, 2014 deadline date will be considered invalid and the student will be ineligible to participate in the program.

Students will be notified of results the week of March 17, 2014.
