Department heads were reminded to have representation at the February 24 recruitment function.

It was agreed that April 15 or 22 would be target dates for the student awards ceremony. Ms. Bryant will check for conflicts on that date and also the availability of the Regency Room at South Campus.

Plans for attendance at AERA and MSERA were discussed. Dr. Evans pointed out that we are members of MSERA, and Dr. Tony Norman is our official representative.

LTC Powell announced that a blood drive will be held on February 6 at DUC and the Military Ball is scheduled for April 13. He commented briefly on the internship program.
