## Minutes Administrative Council - College of Education and Behavioral Sciences Thursday, July 5, 2001 – 8:30 a.m. Dean's Conference Room, Tate Page Hall

Material was distributed and discussed regarding Program Productivity Review and the budget reduction plan. The specific amount of Western's cut should be known by late July, but department heads should begin thinking about how they plan to address the issue.

Drs. Adams and Evans will meet with Dr. Burch on Monday regarding the staffing plan. As soon as they have information, they will share it with department heads.

The Council members were invited by Dr. Metze to tour the lab and observe the new hardware and software. While in the lab, he announced that on August 8, an Etrain Express Institute will be held. He anticipates that 2-3 faculty members from each department will be invited.
