New Business

From the Department of Educational Administration, Leadership and Research

▪Revise Course Grading System – EDLD 798, Int/Admin & Supervision
There was a Whetstone/Berger motion to approve/second. A few edits were mentioned and noted. The implementation date was changed to spring 2012. The motion passed.

From the Educational Leadership Doctoral (EDD) Program

▪Create a New Course – EDLD 712, Research Methods and Design for Educational Leaders
There was a Berger/Carter motion to approve/second. Tony Norman presented. This course is to replace the current EDLD 711 Methodology in Leadership Research course. This new course will focus more on research methods rather than developing research critiques. The implementation date was changed to spring 2012.

Other Business
