- Create a New Course – IECE 423G, Interdisciplinary Services for Young Children with Low Incidence Disabilities

- Revise a Program – 144, Interdisciplinary Early Childhood Education (IECE)

There was a Berger/Battles motion to approve/second. Vicki Stayton presented. After some discussion about exit requirements, it was agreed to withdraw this proposal at this time. Revisions will be made and brought back to committee. It was agreed that the above proposal, Create a New Course – IECE 423G will be held and go to Graduate Council along with the revision of program 144 once it is approved.
