New Business

■Revise a Program – 754, Major in Physics

Department of Mathematics and Computer Science

■Revise Course Catalog Listing – MATH 304, Applications and Explorations

There was a McDaniel/Swanson motion to approve/second. Hope Marchionda explained that preservice mathematics teachers at both the middle and secondary levels are required to take this course. The motion passed.

■Revise Course Prerequisites/Corequisites – STAT 301, Introductory Probability and Applied Statistics

There was a Croxall/Boman motion to approve/second. Hope Marchionda presented. This revision complies with the current departmental requirement that all mathematics courses listed as prerequisites for other MATH/STAT courses must be completed with grades of C or better. It was agreed that the implementation date for this course will be changed to Spring 2012. The motion passed.
