Graduate Assistant Instructor Certificate of Distinction

The goal of this certificate is to promote and acknowledge the work our teaching assistants do in the Department of Communication.

Criteria/Eligibility:

- 1. Teaching assistant must be the instructor of record for at least one course section.
- 2. Teaching assistant must have strong teaching evaluations (e.g., reasonable distribution of grades, at or above department average on evaluation items, qualitative comments demonstrating positive learning experiences for students).

Process:

- ➤ Teaching assistants apply for certificate and submit a packet with the following materials by April 1:
 - Nomination letter (description of what they learned and how they grew as a teacher through the teaching assistantship experience, including their experience in COMM 145, COMM 510 (teaching strategies course), and any sections they assisted with in the department)
 - Faculty letter supporting their development and growth as a teacher
 - Teaching portfolio (teaching evaluations, teaching philosophy, original teaching activity)
- Ad hoc committee consisting of graduate faculty and basic course director assesses the submissions. The committee will make decisions by April 15.
