### 2, 3, 4 Year MCFC Fall Cohort (60 hours)

Possible options for Elective Courses are noted in red font and may include courses (a) required for the Addictions Education Graduate Certificate (AE); (b) courses required for the College and Career Readiness Graduate Certificate (CCR); (c) in MCFC; or (d) in Play/Expressive Arts Therapy (PET). Electives offered through the Department are dependent on faculty availability and course enrollment. Elective options may also be offered during the winter term or sought outside of the Department; seek advisor approval.

A grade of B or better is required in CNS 591 and both sections of CNS 596 to meet graduation requirements. In order to register for CNS 591, a B must be earned in the following 5 courses: CNS 554; CNS 555; CNS 558; CNS 559; CNS 560.
