The following four-year plan is an example of how to map your program in consultation with your film faculty advisor. Every student will finish with a unique plan of his/her own depending on the minor area of study and electives selected.

Admission: Students wishing to enter the major in film initially are admitted as majors seeking admission (reference 667P). Prospective majors may take no more than 15 hours in the major before admission. Students must meet the following requirements before they can be admitted:

1. Completion of a minimum of 24 hours of course work applicable to a baccalaureate degree;
2. A minimum overall grade point average of 2.5;
3. Completion of ENG 100 with a grade of 'C' or better and nine additional hours in the General Education Program;
4. Completion of the following courses with a grade of 'C' or better: FILM 101 and FILM 201.

Students not meeting the above admission requirements will not be admitted to the major in film and cannot register for any additional courses in the major.

CURRICULUM: The major in film (reference number 667) requires a minimum of 36 semester hours and leads to a Bachelor of Arts degree. Students must earn a grade of "C" or better in all required courses applied to the film major. One-half of the hours (18-hours) in the film major must be at the 300 or 400 level. Students are encouraged to participate in relevant study abroad opportunities. A minor or a second major in another discipline outside the area of mass communication is required. No more than 6 hours in the film major may count toward a student's minor. Refer to the University catalog for more information. <http://www.wku.edu/undergraduatecatalog/index.php>
