Prospective majors may take no more than 15 hours in the major before admission. Students must meet the following requirements before they can be admitted:					
<ol> <li>Completion of a minimum of 24 hours of course work applicable to a baccalaureate degree;</li> </ol>						
	<ol> <li>A minimum overall grade point average of 2.5;</li> <li>Completion of ENG 100 with a grade of 'C' or better and nine additional hours in the General Education Program;</li> <li>Completion of the following courses with a grade of 'C' or better: FILM 101 and FILM 201.</li> <li>Students not meeting the above admission requirements will not be admitted to the major in film and cannot register for any additional courses in the major.</li> <li>CURRICULUM: The major in film (reference number 667) requires a minimum of 36 semester hours and leads to a Bachelor of Arts degree. Students must</li> </ol>					
	earn a grade of "C" or better in all required courses applied to the film major. One-half of the hours (18-hours) in the film major must be at the 300 or 400 level. Students are encouraged to participate in relevant study abroad opportunities. A minor or a second major in another discipline outside the area of mass communication is required.
