Admission to the Gordon Ford College of Business and the Management (Human Resources) Major – To gain admission to the Gordon Ford College of Business (GFCB) and the Management (Human Resources) Major students must have 60 earned hours with a minimum 2.5 overall GPA. They must also complete the eight admission courses\* (ACCT 200, ACCT 201; CIS 141; COMM 145; ECON 202, ECON 203, ECON 206; MATH 116 (or higher)). Management (Business Administration) majors must also earn a separately calculated 2.5 GPA in ACCT 200; CIS 141; COMM 145; ECON 202, ECON 206; and MGT 210 (with a grade of "C" or higher in MGT 210).
