The major in criminology requires a minimum of 34 credit hours. Students majoring in criminology must select a minor or second major. The program requires completion of 22 hours of core courses: CRIM 101, CRIM 330, CRIM 332, CRIM 380, CRIM 499, SOCL 300 SOCL 302, and SOCL 309. In addition, the students are required to take an additional 12 hours of elective courses selected from the following list.
