The suggested program of study shown below should be used in consultation with your advisor(s). Every student will finish with a unique plan of his/her own depending on the electives selected. The Journalism major requires 42 hours and a minor or 2nd major outside the School and the Department of Communication. All incoming students come in "Seeking Admission" and must complete ENG 100 with a grade of "C" or higher and nine additional hours of Colonnade. Additionally, Journalism majors must complete SJB 101, SJB 102, and JOUR 202, complete twenty-four degree hours and earn an Overall Grade Point Average of at least 2.5 to be "Officially Admitted" into the major.
