\*\*Note: all general education courses and nursing prerequisites must be completed prior to entry into the major at the Junior level. All sciences must be completed with a grade of C or above. A two course Anatomy and Physiology sequence must have been completed no more than 5 years prior to application and must have been completed at the same institution. Additional testing, fees and deadlines apply. Talk with a pre-nursing advisor for details concerning application.
