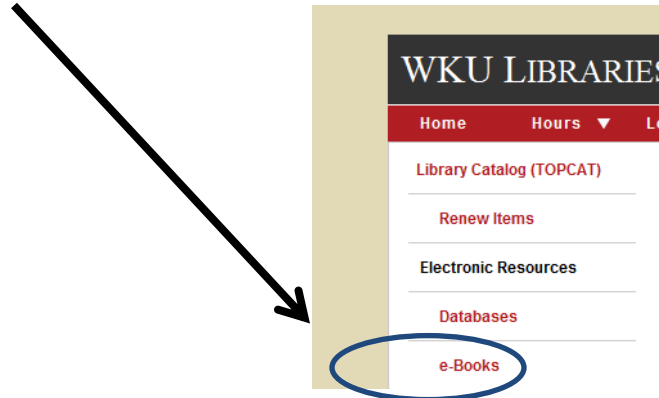


# Finding E-books at WKU

WKU Libraries Catalog, TOPCAT, can be used to check the availability of E-books in our collection

1. To look for Ebooks go to [www.wku.edu/libraries](http://www.wku.edu/libraries)
2. Click on the **e-books** link at the left of the page.

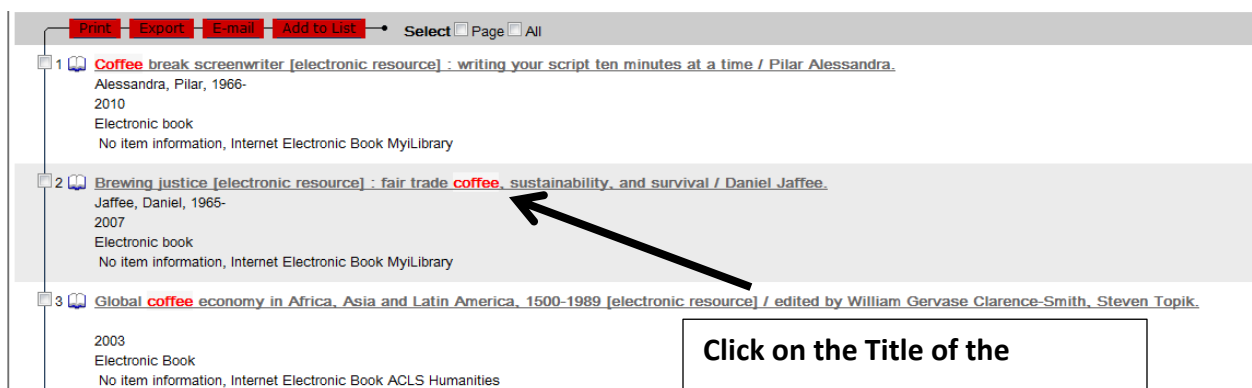


This will open a TOPCAT search which will be restricted to results in the e-book format. **The default is to search for a topic by keyword**, so you will get any e-books which have your keyword in the title.

**Use the drop down menu to search for an exact title if you are looking for a specific book.**



3. Put a term in the **Search Box** and click on the Search Button. Your results will look like this:



**Click on the Title of the Book to access the e-book .**

4. To open and access the E-book, click on the **Connect to MyiLibrary resource** where it says Linked Resources.
