

Bubble Systems

You will blow a matrix or cluster of bubbles on to the table top and observe what you see happening. Write your observations down in your journal. You may include drawings if you'd like.

1. Use the damp sponge to moisten the table top. You just need a damp patch to blow bubbles on to, not a big lake of water!
2. Blow a bubble on to the surface of the table the same way you were instructed to in the Bubble Corral. Then, take a WET drinking straw blow through it to add another bubble right next to your first one. The two bubbles should be attached. What do you notice?
3. Add more bubbles to the cluster. Add them around your original bubble and even on top if you want to! Really look carefully.... what do you notice now?
4. As the bubbles begin to burst, observe the changes within the bubble cluster. What do you notice?
