WKU School of Kinesiology, Recreation & Sport 2021-22 Graduate Assistantships (8)

The WKU School of Kinesiology, Recreation & Sport (KRS) is seeking talented applicants for Graduate Assistantships in the following academic units: Exercise Science, Physical Education, Recreation Administration, Sport Management, and Recreation & Sport Administration (graduate program). Each position is nine-months in duration and appointments are contingent upon admission into a School of KRS graduate program.

Position Overview

All School of KRS GA's are assigned to a specific academic unit to assist with overall functionality of that program. Additionally, GA's will be assigned to a faculty supervisor within that unit. Each position will have unique responsibilities and duties relative to the academic unit and the teaching, research, and service agenda of the supervising faculty member.

Each GA is on a nine-month contract and required to work 20 hours per week. GA's coordinate their weekly schedule and office hours with their faculty supervisor. Continuance for a second year appointment is contingent upon funding available in the School of KRS, satisfactory academic performance, and successful completion of duties as assigned in the initial appointment period.

Compensation & Tuition Coverage

GA's receive a \$9,500 stipend for the nine-month position as well as tuition coverage for three on-campus courses per semester. Additional course fees, distance learning fees, etc. are the responsibility of the student.

Review of application materials will begin on April 16, 2021 by faculty within each academic unit.
