What is JUMP?

Joint Undergraduate-Master's Programs (JUMP) provide undergraduate students the opportunity to begin working toward an M.S. in Recreation & Sport Administration (RSA). These students may take graduate courses that count toward their undergraduate and graduate degree.

Benefits

- Double-count 12 graduate hours
- Significantly lower the cost of obtaining a master's degree
- Reduce the overall time of completing the RSA graduate program

Eligibility

- REC or SPM Major
- 60 to 100 undergrad hours completed
- 3.2+ GPA

RSA Graduate Program

- M.S. in Recreation & Sport Administration (on campus or online)
- Graduate certificate programs
- Experienced faculty
- Emphasis on practical experience and networking

Application Process

Interested students will submit a Statement of Intent to enter the JUMP and will be guided through the application process by the RSA program coordinator.
