Western Kentucky University has a new vice president.

Susan Ingram Howarth was appointed Wednesday as executive vice president for strategy, operations and finance at WKU.

She will replace Ann Mead, senior vice president for finance and administration, who is retiring June 30 after 25 years of service, a news release said.

Currently the director of decision support at the University of Louisville, Howarth will begin her duties at WKU on June 17, the release said.

“We are excited to find someone with (Howarth’s) experience to provide leadership for WKU’s strategic, operational and financial functions,” WKU President Timothy Caboni said in the news release. “In this new position, Susan will manage all aspects of the university’s operating budget to ensure that the use of funds and other resources advances the university’s overall goals.”

Howarth has a bachelor’s degree in business administration and finance from the University of Louisville and a master’s degree in finance from Northern Illinois University.

“This feels like a kind of homecoming for me,” Howarth said in the release. “Although I grew up in Louisville, my father was from Butler County and we spent many weekends in the area. I also spent my first year in college at WKU, so I’m excited to be coming back.”
