Major Triads

Learn to spell these Major triads. Then, using the procedures from the TRIADS page, you can spell the minor, augmented and diminished triads. Since there are no commonly used Major scales for Fb, D#, E#,G#, A# and B#, take note of how to spell these triads.

HINT: With the exception of the B major triad, all major triads that begin on white notes are either spelled completely with white notes OR the third is sharp. The third and the fifth are sharp in the B major triad.



HINT: With the exception of the Bb major triad, all major triads that begin on flat notes are either spelled completely with flat notes OR only the root and fifth are flat. Only the root is flat in the Bb major triad.



HINT: All major triads that begin on sharp notes are either spelled completely with sharp notes OR the third is double sharp and the fifth is sharp. The B# major triad has a double sharp on the third AND the fifth.
