

## Transfer Student Guide for the WKU BSN Program

1. This guide lists classes which WKU nursing students must take **in addition** to meeting general education requirements.
2. It is **HIGHLY** recommended that you take all of your general education courses at your current university and transfer to WKU as General Education Certified. Contact your university to see what you need to do to complete general education so you can transfer to WKU General Education Certified. **This must be recorded by the transfer universities registrar's office on your transcript.**
3. **General Education Warning.** If you have not completed all general education at your current institution, you will be required to complete the WKU Colonnade, which is not listed on this document. 4. **Science Grades:** As Science grades are an important part of the admissions ranking process, you must have completed **3 of the 4** required Science Classes with a grade of C or above **PRIOR** to applying to the nursing program. Requires Science classes are Chemistry 109, Biology 207/208, Biology 131 and 231 or approved equivalent courses.
5. Nursing program application deadlines are posted on the nursing website.

**Completion of the above classes does not guarantee admission into the BSN program. Students applying for the BSN program must have a minimum overall GPA of 2.75.**
