COURSE:	HLS 800 - "Foundations of Homeland Security and Emergency Management"
DESCRIPTION:	Organization, missions and critical issues in US homeland security and emergency management. Focuses on developing professional skills in critical thinking, policy analysis and ethics.

COURSE:	HLS 810 - "Infrastructure Protection and Risk Analysis"
DESCRIPTION:	Foundations for providing security and resilience to the nation's critical infrastructure with an emphasis on risk management.

COURSE:	HLS 830 - "Natural Hazards and Threats to the Nation"
DESCRIPTION:	Description and analysis of significant hazards and threats to national security, and community safety, such as disasters, catastrophes, accidents, epidemics, technological failures and terrorism.

COURSE:	HLS 831 - "Evolution in Emergency Management"
DESCRIPTION:	Current practices of emergency management evolved through governmental reactions to disasters that helped shape current emergency management practices, policy, administrative changes and historical context for the changes.
