An ally is a person who supports equal civil rights, gender equality, and LGBTQ+ social movements, challenging homophobia, biphobia, and transphobia.

An ally acknowledges that LGBTQ+ people face discrimination and thus are socially disadvantaged. They aim to use their position and privilege in a society focused on cis normativity and heteronormativity to counter discrimination against LGBTQ+ people.
