

Workforce Development Plan

The MPH-BSPH programs advance public health practice by addressing the professional development needs of the current public health workforce.

In addition to offering undergraduate and graduate certificates institutionally, faculty organize and/or provide a minimum of one workshop each year to one of our priority populations, based on needs identified through mixed-methods: Advisory meetings; AHD meetings; informal needs assessments; conversations with stakeholders; and state-wide initiatives (e.g. BECKY).

Our workforce development plan targets two primary priority populations:

1. Academic Health Department (AHD) partners, with whom we have a mutual service relationship
2. Agencies in Warren County serving the marginalized populations, and the priority populations identified in our diversity plan.
