The following guidelines must be met for the WKU Owensboro Scholarship Committee to consider your application:

1. *Applicant must be a graduate of Hancock County High School. Documentation required before processing application.*
First time applicants must submit HCHS transcript with application to be considered. You may contact HCHS 270-927-6953 or the Hancock County Board of Education 270-927-6914 to retrieve the information. Former Badgett Applicants do not need to submit a transcript from HCHS.
2. Applicant has earned at least a 2.0 cumulative grade point average out of a 4.0 system.
3. Applicant is enrolled in a degree program at WKU Owensboro.
4. Applicant has completed a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for the candidate's application to be considered. WKU school code #002002. Please keep in mind that it can take up to 6 weeks for your FAFSA to process and be sent to WKU. *Applicants are encouraged to complete a FAFSA as close to opening date as possible. If selected for verification by the Federal Government, no award can be made by WKU until that process is complete with KHEEA.*
5. All applicants must have a FAFSA on file with WKU. Award is based upon prevailing tuition rates to include fees for the course. Financial assistance received from other scholarships, grants, and/or tuition reimbursement will be deducted from tuition before awarding the Badgett Scholarship. Students receiving CAP/Pell will receive \$125.00 book allowance per course after scholarships, grants, and/or tuition reimbursement amounts have been deducted from tuition.
6. Applicant has completed the General Scholarship Application on TopDollar. Please visit www.wku.edu/TopDollar to access the application.
7. This scholarship is **not** automatically renewable, but applicants may submit for consideration each semester (spring, summer and fall) by the designated deadlines listed below.

Please note: Award notification will be sent in the form of an e-mail to your WKU TopperMail account. Awards will be applied to your WKU bill after the semester's last "Drop/Add" date. Until the award is
