

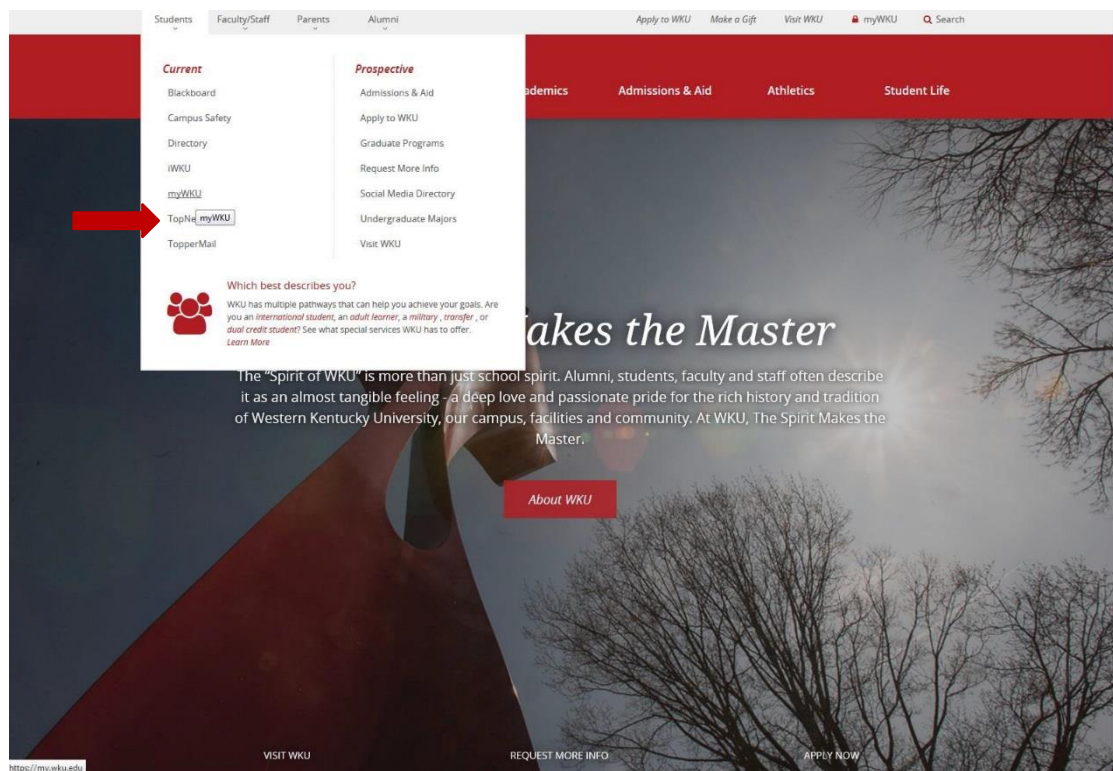
A step-by-step guide for completing the General Scholarship Application

To apply for WKU scholarships:

- You must be admitted to WKU
- You must have access to your WKU NetID and password
- You must complete the General Scholarship Application

Start by going to <http://www.wku.edu/>

Find and hover your mouse over the student tab in the top left corner, and then click on TopNet



To sign in to TopNet

In the center of the page, enter your NetID or WKU ID number. Your pin number will be the last 8 digits of your social security number. Enter and click “log-in”. You will be asked to change the PIN number to a 6 digit number.

If you do not know your WKUID or NetID:

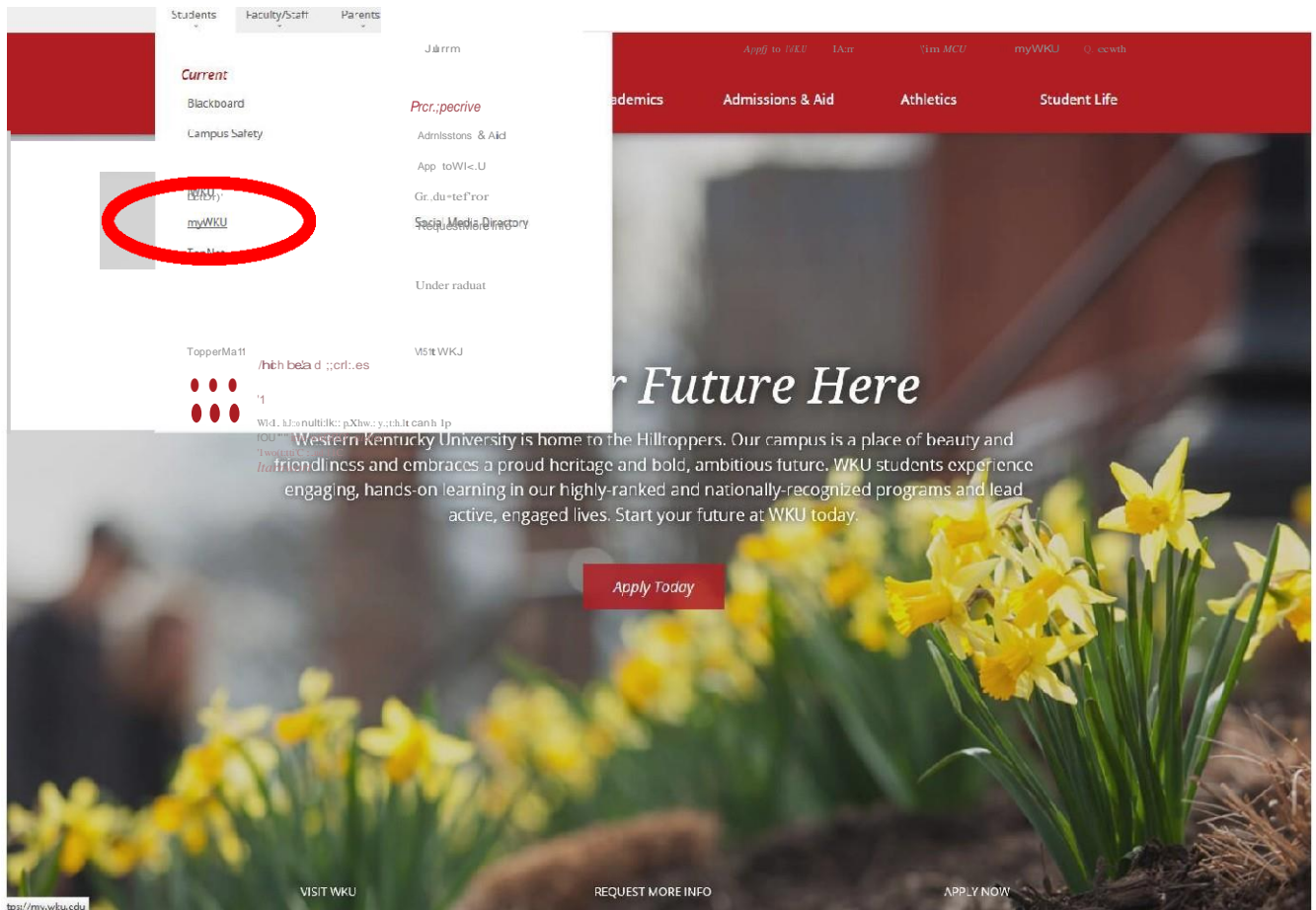
On the right side of the page, there is a “Need Help?” section.

If you know your WKUID or NetID and password, then go to www.wku.edu, find and hover your mouse over the student tab in the top left corner, and then click on myWku.

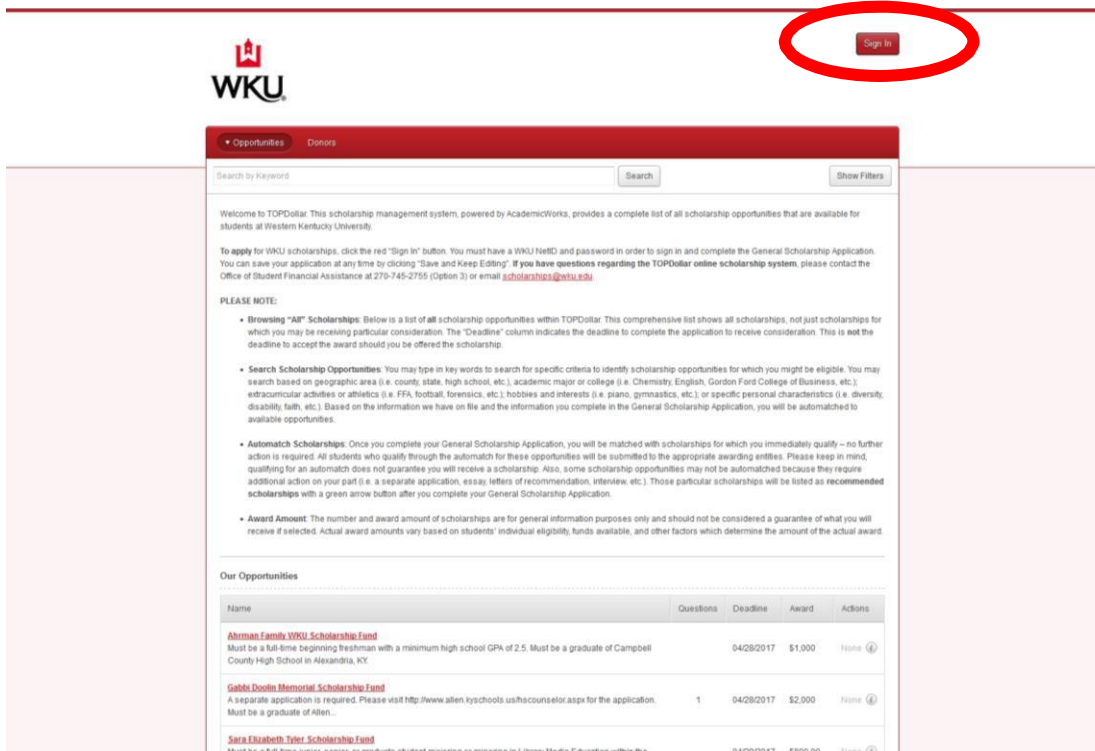

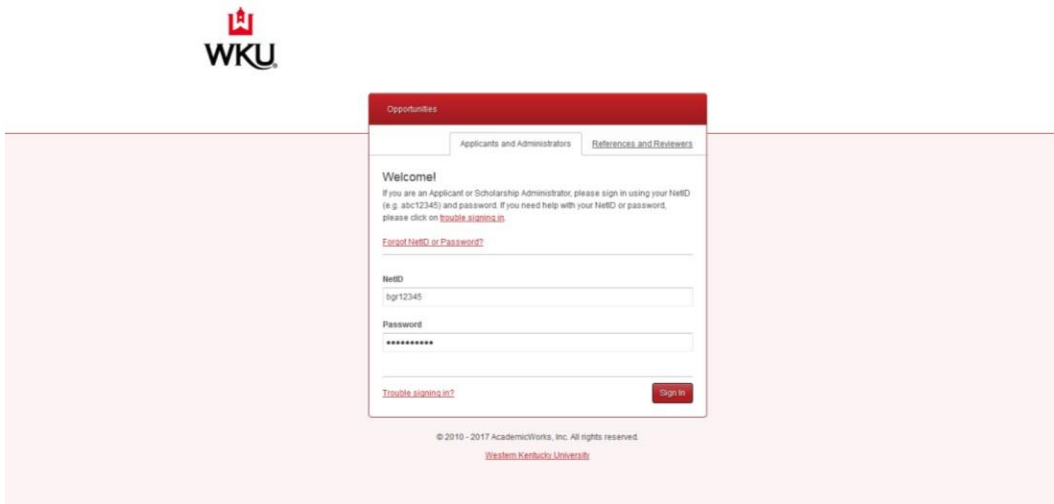
