

Proposal to Amend WKU Faculty Handbook: Substantive Change

1. Type of Change:

Current wording:

[There is not current wording addressing this issue. Change is adding the sentence “If any due dates fall on a weekend or university holiday, then the due date will be moved to the next business day.” to various sections where specific due dates are listed. Addition is placed at the end of Introduction paragraph in III. and IV. There is no introduction for section X, so the sentence will be added prior to X.A.]

Proposed wording:

If any due dates fall on a weekend or university holiday, then the due date will be moved to the next business day.

3. Rationale for amendment:

Clarifies that due dates for items in those sections will be for “next business day” if the specified date falls on a weekend or university holiday.
