Bill 19-22-S. A Bill to Amend the Student Government Association Constitution.

PURPOSE: For the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University to amend Section 1.5.1 of its Constitution.

WHEREAS: Section 1.5.1 describes the University's non-discrimination clause and where to report sex and gender-based discrimination, and

WHEREAS: The current text lists Deborah Wilkins' contact information for the Title IX Coordinator, and

WHEREAS: Contact information for university officers in the Constitution needs to be up to date, especially for a University office as critical as the Title IX office, and

WHEREAS: Section 1.5.1 shall now read as follows:

“The University is also required to investigate complaints of sex and gender-based discrimination. All sex and gender-based discrimination and harassment allegations can be reported to Ms. Andrea Anderson (Interim Title IX Coordinator and General Counsel) via email at titleix@wku.edu or by phone at (270) 745-5398.”, and,

WHEREAS: When a permanent Title IX coordinator is appointed for the university, it is recommended that the Constitution be amended to reflect the name, title, and contact information of the new coordinator.

THEREFORE: Be it resolved that the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University will amend Section 1.5.1 of its Constitution.
