“Establishment of a Special Long-Term Goals Committee”

Pursuant to clause 2.3.7 of the Constitution of the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University, the President may “[e]stablish special committees within the Senate as needed with the approval of the majority of the Senate.”

As a student advocacy organization, the Student Government Association is responsible for pursuing positive change across Western Kentucky University for the benefit of the student body. Over the past few years, the specific goals for each year have varied with the election of new executive officers. Long-term goals are important to consistent and quality leadership in any organization.

Therefore, a student committee should be established to draft long-term goals in various areas of student governance that would be shared from one administration to the next. This committee would consist of no less than 8 members appointed by the President of the Student Government Association with advice and consent of the Speaker of the Student Senate.

At least one member of each of the branches of the Student Government Association shall be appointed to serve on this special committee. The President shall also appoint a number of students not involved in the Student Government Association to serve on this special committee. The President and Speaker shall serve as ex-officio members, and the committee shall elect their own chairperson.

The chairperson shall report to the Student Senate monthly until the committee is dissolved. The committee will draft long-term goals and present this draft for the approval of the Student Senate and the Executive Cabinet.
